Leaders, innovators, and communities from around the world will come together to showcase and deliberate on a bold, collective agenda. They will leave Nairobi equipped with new connections, ideas, practical tools, and plans for a shared vision that serves humanity.

### Why this matters now

The joint event is designed for collaboration, outcomes and action. Technical discussions sit alongside policy dialogues; the exhibition space gathers industry players, research institutions, agencies, partners and startups; workshops support practitioners and early-career talent; and voices of the future are given audience. The emphasis is on connection and creating impact in a space designed for people to find each other, compare approaches, learn, share, and align on next steps. The exhibition serves as a platform for the space and data ecosystems to showcase solutions, products, and open doors to collaboration.

We anticipate 1,500+ participants from 90+ countries, with strong representation from governments, multilateral organizations, businesses, civil society, academia, and innovators.
